CARBON EMISSIONS

Carbon dioxide and other greenhouse gases are released into the atmosphere whenever fossil fuels are used. Transportation in general has been identified as a major contributor of carbon emissions worldwide and aviation in particular is increasingly in the spotlight as a contributor to the growing amount of CO₂ being released in the atmosphere.

CO₂ is a greenhouse gas that contributes to climate change when released from fossil fuels such as oil, gas and coal as they are burnt. Greenhouse gas emissions are considered the major cause of ozone depletion and climate change and CO₂ is the major contributor to this effect.

We can all take simple steps to reduce the amount of CO₂ we produce and offset the rest.

Carbon offsetting allows you to offset carbon emissions resulting from operating your aircraft by funding projects that will reduce an equal amount of carbon dioxide emissions in key areas worldwide.

OUR PROGRAM

Together, Bombardier and Climate Care offer a simple and robust way to offset your business aircraft's carbon emissions.

The amount of CO₂ produced by your aircraft is calculated based on an average yearly utilization and fuel consumption. The number of tonnes of carbon produced by your aircraft is then multiplied by a fixed offsetting cost per tonne. You then pay a fixed annual fee, which will be invested in projects to reduce an equal amount of emissions.

Bombardier forwards your contribution to Climate Care who in turn uses the carbon offsetting funds to invest in award-winning, low carbon technology projects that not only reduce carbon dioxide emissions, but benefit communities and wildlife worldwide.

THESE PROJECTS INVOLVE:

Renewable energy

Replaces non-renewable fuel such as coal, gas and non-renewable wood sources

Energy efficiency

Reduces the amount of fuel needed

As well as taking steps to reduce your carbon footprint you can offset what remains, thereby helping to promote low-carbon technologies where they have the greatest impact.

Bombardier, on behalf of Climate Care, acknowledges your contribution with a special receipt and will provide you with a timely update on the projects they are currently funding around the world.

Based in the UK and owned by JPMorgan, a leading investment bank, Climate Care is a world leading offset provider. Founded in 1997, Climate Care makes reductions of greenhouse gases such as CO₂ on behalf of individuals and companies. The funds generated by the Bombardier carbon offset program with Climate Care will be invested in a global portfolio of low carbon technology projects.

Climate Care invests the carbon offset funds in a project portfolio, rather than in any one particular project. This approach allows Climate Care to provide funding up front for projects, as well as to manage risk.

Through Climate Care, the Bombardier Business Aircraft carbon offset program adheres to strict **project principles**:

Additionality

Climate Care will only fund a project if it would not have gone ahead without their assistance. This means that all the emissions reductions paid for by your participation in the program go over and above what would have happened without their intervention. This is why Climate Care chooses to invest in developing countries, as they do not have sophisticated climate change policies in place and are constrained by lack of access to capital.

Avoid Double Counting

All countries that have signed up and ratified the Kyoto Protocol have legally binding targets to reduce their greenhouse gas emissions. We believe that our customers want their money to fund CO₂ reductions that go over and above those that governments are already required to make. That is why Climate Care funds projects outside countries that have legally binding commitments under the Kyoto Protocol.

Third party verification

For each project, Climate Care involves a third party responsible for setting out the project baseline. The third party also provides ongoing monitoring to ensure that the expected emission reductions are being made.

Project Standards

Climate Care projects are accredited from CDM, Gold Standard or Voluntary Carbon Standard.
